MISSOURI TBF STUFF

In August MO-TBF will vote on the format of future Divisional tournaments. The MOTBF directors have asked for our opinion on the issue... The vote is to conduct the divisional the same as other FLW formats. Meaning boaters will fish against boaters and co-anglers against co-anglers similar to a Pro-Am. This will not affect our state tournament as the top 12 Missouri anglers will still advance to the divisional. Under the current format of the Divisional the top 2 anglers from the Missouri 12 advance to Nationals (1st place as a boater, and the 2nd as a co-angler). Under the New proposed format, out of the 12 man Missouri team the 1st - 6th place anglers will boat and compete for one Nationals boater position, and the 7th-12th place anglers will compete for one Nationals co-angler position. In this new divisional Pro-Am type format the co-angler will not have control of the boat & half the day's water as they do during our state tournament. Please give it some thought and share your opinion at the next meeting.

Central Pro Am Moved

(Clinton, MO) Central Pro Am Association President Kevin Bowling announced Sunday, July 08, 2007 his decision to move the location of the 2007 Truman Lake Pro Am. "Due to the recent rains in Eastern Kansas and Western Missouri, Truman Lake has risen over 23 feet in the last week," began Bowling. "The Corps of Engineers has

restricted access to Truman to 'high water ramps' only, limiting access to the lake," he finished. The ramp and parking lot at Bucksaw Resort have been breached, making it impossible to hold a tournament at that site.
